SATURDAY JUNE 13 DEADWOOD TOUR

Time: 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. **5 Hours**

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$20

Enjoy bus transportation to historic Deadwood, an old west gold town. It is an easy walking on the same streets as Wild Bill Hickok, Calamity Jane, and Seth Bullock. Or there are trolleys running on the historic streets. This trip will provide an opportunity to visit the casinos for some old time western-style gambling.

SUNDAY JUNE 14 HILL CITY 1880 TRAIN TOUR

Leave: 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. **5 Hours**

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$20, and (optional) Train Ride \$18

Travel to Keystone through the beautiful Black Hills. Once in Keystone, board the 1880 Train with the famous historic steam engine and enjoy the charms of the scenic hills winding between Keystone and Hill City. Upon arrival at Hill City, you will be transported to main street where you will have time to visit the many quaint shops and eat lunch. Then it's back into Rapid City to freshen up for the opening session which begins at 2 p.m. NOTE: *The 1880 train is optional, but to go on the train your reservation must be made with pre-payment.*

MONDAY JUNE 15 BADLANDS TOUR

Leave: 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. **8 Hours**

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$35 (includes the park entrance fee)

Board the bus at the host hotel, go to Cedar Pass, and back through the Badlands' loop to Wall, SD. The unique landscape of the Badlands National Park is truly like no other on the face of the earth. The tour will stop at the Park Headquarters and other scenic places along the highway allowing you to enjoy the spectacular scenery. Lunch will be at the world-famous Wall Drug. From Wall the tour will head back to Rapid City for caucus meetings, the western cookout, and evening outing to Mount Rushmore. *This will be full but fun day - a sightseer's paradise.*

TUESDAY JUNE 16 SOUTHERN HILLS TOUR

Leave: 9:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. **6.5 Hours**

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$30 (includes the park entrance fee)

This bus tour will take you to beautiful Sylvan Lake for a walk along the shore and/or a visit to the gift shop. The tour will continue along the incredible Needles Highway to Blue Bell Lodge and through the hills with a scenic overlook stop at Coolidge. This tour will also include the Wildlife Loop through Custer State Park, which boasts the world's largest buffalo herd, begging burros (we'll pack goodies to feed the burros), prairie dog towns, and a great variety of wildlife. Lunch will be at the Game Lodge, which served as the Summer Whitehouse for Presidents Coolidge and Eisenhower. From there you will return to Rapid City to freshen up for an evening at Crazy Horse Monument. *This will be another full but fun day packed with beautiful and unforgettable sights. Don't forget your camera.*

WEDNESDAY JUNE 17 [NORTHERN HILLS TOUR, Option 1](#)

Leave: 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. **5 Hours**

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$20

This tour will go through the Black Hills National Cemetery on the way to Sturgis, the site of the annual August motorcycle rally. From Sturgis, the tour will travel up Boulder Canyon to Deadwood, where you may see some of the great historical sites or spend some time gambling. You will have the option of doing a walking tour or taking the recommended original Deadwood tour which cost about \$8. This narrated tour is an hour long and hits all of the main historical and interesting areas in Deadwood. We will meet at a designated site for lunch and a speaker from the underground laboratory who will share information on the new national research use for the Homestake Gold Mine. After lunch, it's back to Rapid City in time for the annual business meeting and conference closing.

WEDNESDAY JUNE 17 [PITTMAN DAIRY FARM TOUR, Option 2](#)

Leave: 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. **5 Hours**

Lunch: provided by the Jarvi Family

Cost: \$25

This van tour will take you to the Black Hills National Cemetery, on to Sturgis, and then to the small rural community of Belle Fourche. Be prepared for the sights, sounds, and smells of the Pittman dairy farm located on the bumpy, gravel Jarvi Road. This dairy farm has been in operation by IAWP member Marcia Hultman's family for four generations and is the *real deal!* You will tour this farm - walk in the mud, milk a cow, feed a calf, see the peacocks and sheep, toss a hay bale, and experience the day-to-day activities of a working farm. The Pittmans also raise Spanish Mustangs – the original Indian ponies, and a short horse ride will be offered. An authentic cowboy lunch will be provided by Marcia's family for the tour participants. See first-hand how agriculture serves as a significant part of the South Dakota economy. After lunch, it's back to Rapid City in time for the annual business meeting and conference closing.
